

Dave Miller Gaming Primm

Las Vegas Blvd (LVB) runs a few hundred yards to the east of, and somewhat parallel to, I-15 -- from North Las Vegas, 48 miles to Primm Nevada, where it becomes the resort and outlet mall's perimeter road.

Seven Magic Mountains is 25 miles from Downtown LV and is only accessible from LVB. I-15 interchanges are 8 miles north in Sloan, or 6 miles south in Jean.

Primm is home to three casinos. They are a lot closer to each other than this map suggests. Additionally, there's a Prizm managed outlet mall, and the famous Lottery store. Famous because Nevada doesn't have the lottery, so Las Vegas come here to get their lottery fix. It's accessible only from the perimeter roads, but located on the California side of the state line.

While the trip is normally a quick, relaxing ride, the exception is each weekend when Southern California visitors are going home. An agricultural checkpoint a few miles into CA causes backups several hours long during those return trips.
